EDUCATIONAL

The coffee fundraiser is unique in that it can provide educational tools and training for parents, teachers, and students. Our Shared Forest teaching kits, family science nights, and lesson plans will introduce important ecological concepts including migration, forest ecosystems, conservation, predator-prey relationships, and more. Students will develop environmental awareness through hands-on learning as they investigate the web of life that connects us. All materials are correlated to the Georgia state standards.

ENVIRONMENTALLY FRIENDLY

Sun grown coffee has devastated migratory bird habitats around the world. Shade-grown coffee plantations support many species of birds that winter in South America, but spend their summers in Georgia. Over 24 species of birds migrate between Georgia and Ecuador. In supporting this program, schools are supporting the continual restoration and conservation of these valuable natural resources in Ecuador.

GOOD FOR YOUR SCHOOL

Schools can raise money and awareness by selling a high quality, environmentally sound product. Year-round fundraising offers on-going support for programming needs. Or profits can be used for environmental stewardship programs such as purchasing acres of rainforest for conservation or making a contribution to conservation efforts in Georgia.

AND GOOD FOR THE BIRDS

The Choco Andean Corridor of South America is an area of extremely high biodiversity with 12 internationally recognized Important Bird Areas (IBAs.) In Georgia alone, we have a variety of the forest types that provide habitat for these Neotropical migrant birds, making our home their home each summer. Logging, pesticides, cell phone towers, bright lights, and general habitat destruction have adversely impacted our treasured bird population. Creating awareness in our classrooms around these issues through the Our Shared Forest education programs and service learning offerings will help safeguard these species.

THE COFFEE FUNDRAISER

Café Choco Andes coffee is environmentally friendly shade grown coffee without artificial fertilizers or pesticides. Native coffee farmers profit directly from the sale of the coffee. These coffee berries are hand picked and sorted, hulled, and air-dried in Ecuador. The fresh beans are shipped to Georgia where they are roasted to perfection by 1000faces coffee in Athens. You will receive fresh-roasted coffee delivered directly to your school from the roaster.

SIGNATURE ROASTS

As a special collaborator to this program, 1000faces coffee has created two signature roasts to celebrate our collective conservation efforts: Blackburnian & Tanager. Blackburnian is a full-bodied dark roast with a bold aroma named after the Blackburnian Warbler. Tanager is a balanced medium roast that highlights the distinct flavors of the region, named after the Summer Tanager. These roasts have been named after migratory birds that share forest homes in both Georgia and Ecuador. We offer this coffee in both whole bean and ground.
